About the Coalition

The Minnesota Coalition for Targeted Home Visiting (MCTHV) works together to support our shared vision: All Minnesota families of children age prenatal to five who are at risk for poor mental health, physical health, social, and educational outcomes will have access to intensive, targeted home visiting services to help them succeed in school and in life. Home visiting services will be voluntary, high quality, outcome-focused, and tailored to the resources in each community.

Coalition Partners

Coalition participants include home visiting providers, leaders and managers from non-profit organizations, local public health departments, tribal health departments, health care as well as philanthropy, university and association stakeholders supporting or serving children, youth and families.

Coalition Goals

The Coalition focuses its efforts on two primary goals:

#1. Build a strong infrastructure to support quality-targeted home visiting programs and services.

#2. Increase resources for quality targeted home visiting programs and services.

How to Get Involved

Coalition participants can get involved in a number of ways.

- Quarterly Meetings: The Coalition hosts quarterly meetings to share the work of the Coalition and provide critical networking opportunities for providers and stakeholders.
- Executive Team: Provides leadership for the Coalition
- **Committees:** Two ongoing committees meet and accomplish the goals listed above.
 - Practice Matters Committee: This committee focuses on building the infrastructure to support quality home visiting programs and services regionally and statewide, including addressing local collaboration needs.
 - Legislative Committee: This committee focuses on increasing resources for home visiting services and programs and making it easier to deliver these critical services
- **Training:** Coalition trainings address needs of home visitors and are available to download as podcasts.
- E-Newsletters: Provide information about the Coalition activities and its stakeholders.

Home visiting provides voluntary stabilizing support for families experiencing high-risk factors where they are most comfortable, at home and in their community. Home visiting is a proven strategy to giving families the best start and positioning them for long-term sustainability.
